


Alter® Signal User Manual - Version Date: March 12, 2024



Welcome to Alter®

This user manual provides you with instructions and information about the set-up, operation, use and warranty associated with your Alter Signal™ (the "Signal") device.

To ensure you get the best experience and results from your Alter Signal, it is IMPORTANT that you read this user manual carefully before using your Alter Signal. Failure to follow the Instructions below could result in product damage, malfunction or Injury and void your warranty.

Important Safety Information

Alter Signal <u>is not waterproof</u> and should not be submersed. Care and caution are required so as the Alter Signal or any other Alter devices you wear do not get caught on fixed structures or heavy objects which can cause injury to yourself and/or damage the devices. The Signal charging cable is magnetic and should be kept away from metal objects and remain unplugged from power source when it is not in use.

Prolonged contact with wearable devices may contribute to skin irritation or allergies in some users. To reduce irritation, follow four simple "wear and care" tips: (1) keep it clean, (2) keep it dry, (3) don't wear it too tight, and (4) give your body a rest by removing the band for an hour after extended wear. If you notice any skin irritation, soreness, tingling, numbness, burning, or stiffness in your hands or wrists while or after wearing the Signal, remove your Signal and please discontinue use. If any symptoms persist longer than 2-3 days after removing the device, consult your doctor especially if you have reduced circulation, bruise easily, or have tendonitis, carpal tunnel syndrome, or other musculoskeletal disorders.

Getting Started:

Connecting your Device

- 1) To pair your Signal to the Alter App the Signal should be connected to the charging cable with the cable connected to an appropriate power source.
- 2) Open the Alter App, open Signal Management from the Alter menu and follow the 'Assign a new device' journey.
- 3) Before wearing make sure your Signal is fully charged.
- 4) When using your Signal, double clicking the side button will result in the sync process manually to sync your Signal and the App.

Wearing

For best results, the Alter Signal should be worn on: (1) if using a strap or band, either your wrist or upper arm, or (2) if using the clip, touching your skin between your clothes and your chest in a comfortable location. The Signal should be positioned so as sensor (which has a Green LED) is ideally positioned on the skin near the wrist, upper arm, or chest. When exercising with the Alter, the Signal device should be within close proximity to the Alter and your mobile device that is operating the Screen.

The Signal strap should be threaded through the strap slot and then connected back to the strap itself, so your Signal is snug fit to your wrist or arm. This ensures that the back of the Signal and its sensors make solid contact with your skin.

Charging

You should charge your Alter Signal every 4-6 days or as indicated by either alert received via your Alter App or when the App indicates the battery is low. Battery life is subject to fluctuate depending on use.

Charging time is up to 180 minutes depending on the battery level at time of charging. The Signal will show your charging level in the App itself under 'Your Signal'.

Please use caution with the Signal cable when it is not charging. The Signal charging cable is magnetic and should be unplugged from a power source when not in use. The Signal charging cable nodes should also be kept away from metal objects.

Warning: exposing your Signal to water, extreme temperatures, or damage from strikes may result in a serious lithium battery failure, antenna failure, and may affecting charging capabilities. If the Signal or charging cable sustain damage, do not use them. Contact customer support at support@alterme.com.

Use, Cleaning and Care

Avoid wearing the Signal next to other bracelets or objects which are made of metal, ceramics, or stones, like diamonds as these can scratch or damage your Signal. Alter Signal can scratch objects in close contact such as softer metal jewellery, cell phones and other personal devices made of metal, aluminium or ceramics.

If you experience any discomfort or chafing, adjust your strap tightness. Adjustments may be helpful following exercises as well. Following workouts, ensure that your skin is wiped dry to prevent irritation.

As with any wearable, keeping your Signal clean is important. When removing your Signal to charge, it is recommended that you thoroughly clean your device with a dry washcloth.

WARNING: Alter Signal <u>is not waterproof</u>. We do not recommend swimming, bathing, or showering with the Signal at this time. Do not leave the Signal exposed to heat, such as in a vehicle or in the sun. Do not puncture the Signal or its battery.

The Signal device is a radio transmitter and receiver designed and manufactured not to exceed the emission limits for exposure to radiofrequency (RF) energy set by the Federal Communications Commission of the U.S. Government. The exposure standard for wireless devices employs a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR. SAR refers to the rate at which the body absorbs RF energy. The SAR limit is 1.6 watts per kilogram in countries that set the limit averaged over 1 gram of tissue, and 2.0 watts per kilogram in countries that set the limit averaged over 10 grams of tissue. During testing, the Signal radios are set to their highest transmission levels and SAR is evaluated in real time, over time intervals as specified by applicable regulations. Signals are evaluated in positions that simulate uses against the body and arms with no separation.

Alter and its partners use the latest approved regulatory methods adopted in the industry for testing and managing device radios to meet RF exposure limits.

This Limited Warranty applies, subject to the exclusions and limitations below, only for valid warranty claims made during the applicable warranty period below and only so long as the Signal remains in the possession of the original purchaser, or for a Signal presented as a gift by the original purchaser, the Original Possessor of that Signal.

 Alter Signal — Alter warrants that the Signal provided by Alter will be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of 12 months from the date of original delivery receipt.

Alter will cover the labor costs and, if applicable, the cost of the replacement parts, for an Authorized Third-Party Partner to repair or replace the Signal pursuant to a valid warranty claim made pursuant to this Limited Warranty.

Although you may choose to have the Equipment repaired by someone other than an Authorized Third-Party Partner and it will not void your warranty, if you choose to use someone other than an Authorized Third-Party Partner, Alter shall not be responsible for damage done or additional repairs required based on use of unauthorized parts or repair methods.

At its sole discretion, Alter may fulfill any valid warranty claim by providing a full refund of the price of purchase once the damaged or warranty item is returned to Alter.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Who is covered?

The original purchaser of the Equipment in the United States or Canada. The Equipment must remain in the possession of the original purchaser, or for Equipment presented as a gift by the original purchaser, the Original Possessor ("Original Possessor" means the first user in the U.S. or Canada who completes Alter's online account registration for the Equipment whether that person was the original purchaser or a gift recipient). For the avoidance of doubt, there can only be one person to whom this warranty applies. This Limited Warranty is not transferable.

What IS covered?

- If a defect in workmanship or materials arises in the Equipment during the applicable
 warranty period, the original purchaser's (or, as applicable, the "Original Possessor") sole
 and exclusive remedy is for Alter to, at Alter's sole discretion and to the extent permitted by
 law, either replace or repair the defective Equipment with the same or a comparable model.
- Any replacement or repaired Equipment will be warranted for the remainder of the original applicable warranty period or 30 days from the date of replacement or repair, whichever is longer, or for any additional period that is required by applicable law.

What is NOT covered?

- Any other Alter products or services, non-Alter products or services, labor, Equipment that is, or that Alter reasonably believes to be, stolen, counterfeit, or purchased from an unauthorized distributor or reseller, Equipment purchased or used outside of the 48 contiguous United States, or Equipment that is missing or shows signs of an altered serial number.
